U.S. nod to \$40 mn aid to Sri Lanka

The United States on Saturday announced \$40 million in aid to buy fertilizer and other key agricultural inputs in time for the next cultivation season in crisishit Sri Lanka.

USAID Administrator Samantha Power, who is visiting Sri Lanka, made the announcement after she met farmer representatives in Ja-Ela outside Colombo. She said the money will be in addition to the \$6 million announced earlier to assist low income farmers.

Sri Lanka is facing its worst economic crisis and acute shortages of essentials like food, fuel and medicines.
